The North Shore Boat Club will be offering (2) \$1000 scholarships for the 2020-21 academic year. These will be offered to individuals who will be attending an accredited institution of higher education. Students from the Cedar Valley area or students sponsored by a North Shore Boat Club member would qualify. Judging will be based on (1) eligibility, (2) financial need (3) academic promise and (4) the completion of this application form including all signatures required and submission of all requested materials on or before the May 15, 2020 deadline date. Judging will be made by the North Shore Boat Club scholarship committee during the months of May/June, 2020 with an award ceremony to be held at the following North Shore Boat Club potluck.

• A cover letter telling us about yourself, course of study, goals, any pertinent information that you feel has not already been included herein, as well as a statement describing why you feel you deserve this scholarship. (limit 2 pages or less, font size 12, double spaced)

• 2 letters of recommendation by non-relative adults who have known you for several years, possibly a member of the clergy, an educator, employer, etc.

• Your senior transcript and composite ACT score

• A copy of the school acceptance letter or letter of intent
